SCOPE OF THE COMPETITION

This is an Arizona ONLY Photography event and does not have a qualifying National FBLA Competition. This competitive event is an event that is performed at the conference and submitted for judging.

Event Overview:

Regional Competition ONLY: This event is a pre-judged (pre-submission event)

State Competition: This event will be an on-site one-hour hands on activity where the competitor will need to bring a device with Adobe Photoshop already loaded on it.

The competition will include a series of hands-on performance activities assessing overall photographic editing techniques.

1. Competitors will have one hour to complete this task. Power will be provided.
2. Competitors will be provided two images and edit them based on the instruction sheet given at the competition and export them as a high-resolution JPEG.
 - a. Competitors will be asked to complete tasks that include but are not limited to:
 - i. Adjustment layers
 - ii. Selection Tools
 - iii. Retouching Tools
 - iv. Masking Tools
 - v. Filters
 - vi. Gradients
3. Each participant must have the following required equipment:
 - a. Laptop with Adobe Photoshop software/access.
4. Competitors are expected to follow all applicable copyright laws. Any trademarks, logos, or intellectual property not created by the competitor must be supported by proper documentation.
5. Projects submitted for competition become the property of FBLA. These projects may be used for the publication and/or reproduced for sale by the state or national association.
